I found whether you were raised by an addict or you weren't, those 3 questions really help you live life the way God wants you to.

Just a Thought

March 10th – 11th

Our first reading from the Book of Samuel tells us that even those many centuries ago, there was turmoil within and without the church. Yet in this reading we are reassured by the following words; "Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart. "In all our lives I am sure there have been times when we did the best we could in circumstances but the outcome was not as we hoped. Yet, as noted above, "the Lord looks into the heart. "When we pray each day and ask God to be with us thru that day, we know He will respond. Words come, actions happen and many times we think how did that come about? Dear friends, it came about simply because we asked God for His help and God responded. That's faith, and during this Lenten season it is good to see the suffering of Christ that took place so we could also feel His love. Individual love for every single person created in His image and likeness, we are indeed blessed. Paul reminds us to live as children, not of darkness, but of light, for light produces goodness, righteousness and truth. Just as God did not leave Israel in exile, God does not leave any of us dead to sin.

God's own Son, Jesus was given to us, all He asks is for us to believe in His love and to live aware of His Presence in and thru us.

I close with the simple yet powerful words of our Communion Antiphon:

"The Lord anointed my eyes: I went, I washed, I saw and I believed in God."
